## Yesterday's Happenings:

- JV Volleyball lost to Lexington 12-25, 12-25.
- Varsity Volleyball lost to Lexington 8-25, 9-25, 18-25. Mallory Marmet had 7 kills and 3 aces, Camrie Wilson had 8 assists, and Kylin Kyte had 4 kills.
- Boys Varsity Soccer traveled to Madison for an OCC clash with the Rams. The Knights fell by a final score of 0-6.
- Girls Varsity Soccer beat West Muskingum 7-2. The Lady Knights delivered a dominant performance against the Tornadoes, powered by Charli Murphy's incredible 5-goal, 2-assist effort. Bri Poventud added 2 goals of her own in the commanding win. The Lady Knights opened the scoring when Murphy picked up the ball near midfield, dribbled through the defense, and slotted it into the corner. Her second goal came off a headed pass from Breslyn Brown, which Murphy ran onto and finished calmly. Goal number three followed a perfectly weighted through ball from Codi Murphy, with Charli again finding the back of the net. Murphy's fourth goal was a solo effort after receiving a pass from Kylie Turpen—she weaved through three defenders before beating the keeper. In the second half, Murphy launched a goal kick that soared over the defense, where Poventud ran onto it and buried it in the corner. The duo linked up again when Murphy played a ball over the top, and Poventud brought it down with a great first touch before finishing past the goalie. The final goal of the match came when Murphy picked up the ball in midfield, dribbled through the defense, and tucked it into the corner for her fifth of the night. In goal, Lilli Brown recorded 5 saves, and Saige Krownapple added 3 more to help preserve the win.


