Yesterday's Happenings:

- JV Volleyball lost to Clear Fork 25-23, 22-25, 23-25.
- Varsity Volleyball lost to Clear Fork 10-25, 16-25, 25-19, 24-26. Mallory
 Marmet had 22 kills, 9 blocks, 8 digs, Mati Fair had 15 assists, Lena Burgett
 had 13 assists, Emmy Miller had 8 aces, Harper Warner had 6 digs, and Vivian
 Arbaugh had 7 blocks.
- Boys Varsity Soccer wrapped up the regular season with a 1-1 tie against Loudonville. The game was scoreless for most of the game. Loudonville found the back of the net in the 68th minute to take a one-nil lead late in the match. Jimmy Wengerd moved up from his libero position to the 6 and hit the equalizer in the 74th minute to knot the game up for the Knights. The young Knights would keep the pressure on the 'Birds for the rest of the match but were not able to get the winner to go. The Knights finish the regular season with a 6-9-2 record. They will travel to Maysville next Thursday for a District Tournament game against the Panthers. Maysville, the host, is the 7-seed, and WH is the 11-seed. Kickoff is slated for 6:30 p.m.
- Girls Varsity Soccer came out on top 3-2 in a hard-fought match against the Shelby Whippets, led by Charli Murphy's standout performance. Murphy recorded a hat trick to help secure the win. The scoring began eight minutes into the game when Becca Miller drove down the right wing and played a

squared ball to Murphy. She turned and fired a shot into the bottom corner to give the Knights an early lead. Just eight minutes later, Kathrine Kaster lofted a ball over the top of the defense, finding Murphy on a run. Murphy beat a defender and slotted home her second goal of the match. The Whippets responded early in the second half, scoring within the first few minutes to cut the lead in half. With 17 minutes remaining, Bri Poventud won a ball out of the air, controlled it, and charged downfield, creating a 2v2 situation. She split the defenders with a perfectly weighted pass to Murphy, who beat the goalkeeper to complete her hat trick. The Whippets added a second goal in the final minutes but were unable to find the equalizer. Goalkeeper Landrie Croskey made six saves in net for the Knights. The Lady Knights will open postseason play on Wednesday, October 15, at home against East Liverpool. Kickoff is set for 6:30 p.m.


