- The West Holmes Model United Nations Team traveled to Columbus on Sunday for the Model UN Conference representing the nations of Uganda, Syria, Mexico and Greece.
 - Team Greece consisted of Alexis Wagers, Katherine Kaster, Lee Anna Madison,
 Parker Garver, and Raven Stracke.
 - Team Mexico consisted of Alex McCulloch, Aubree Young, Keaton Conner-Winkler, Lena Burgett, Lilly Perry and Nevaeh Edgell.
 - Team Syria consisted of Bradley Fair, Izzy Fox, Tim Mittman, and Nora Montesterro
 - Team Uganda consisted of Bella Roland, Danica Fritz, Dani Keck, Marley Irias-Bamford, and Nevaeh Mast.
 - Jevin Zheng served as the Human Rights Council president and did an excellent job and Jonny Shedron did an excellent job serving as the General Assembly President.



Rules & Guidelines

- · Physical Artwork (Drawing, painting, etc.), not made on a computer
- Orientation should be landscape like a billboard
- · Billboard content must be factually correct and accurate
- No profanity or inappropriate language, content, etc.
- Must include a clear message that is easy to read while driving and stands out
- Cannot include trademarked or licensed images/ logos

All entries must have a completed Contest Entry Form with parent/ guardian permission

Facts for Inspiration:

- E-cigarettes contain nicotine, cancer- causing chemicals, volatile organic compounds, heavy metals, ultrafine particles, and flavoring chemicals that may be unsafe to inhale.
- · Nicotine can harm brain development, which continues until about age 25.
- Youth nicotine use can harm the parts of the brain that control attention, learning, mood, and impulse control.
- Nicotine levels in vapes have increased over time, making them more addictive than ever.
- Nicotine addiction can worsen feelings of stress, anxiety, and depression.
- Youth that vape may experience health problems like wheezing, nausea, vomiting, headaches and dizziness.
- Vaping can affect athletic performance.
- Vaping can increase the risk of addiction to other drugs in the future.
- Live Vape free is a free resource for Ohio teens and young adults that want to quit vaping.
