**West Holmes Kindergarten Screening  
February 2 – February 28, 2026**

Parents with children who will be five on or before August 20, 2026, are asked to register their child with the West Holmes Elementary School.

Register by calling 330-378-2111.

You will be asked basic information about your child, and a screening time will be assigned.

Once you have called and registered your child for screening, you will receive an email explaining how to log onto the district website, [www.westholmes.org](http://www.westholmes.org), then click on the Final Forms link. From here, you will complete the necessary forms to register. Also, at this time, upload the following documents to Final Forms:

- your child's birth certificate
- immunizations
- proof of residency
- proof of custody (if applicable)
- your photo ID

\*If you bring your child to school or if they walk, please make sure they arrive to school no later than 8:40.

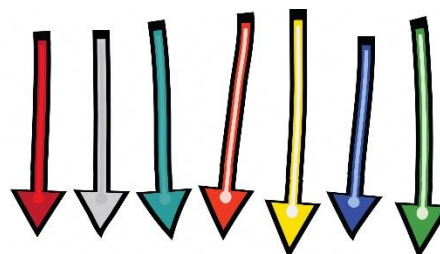
\*If you are picking your child up from school early, a phone call or note is required. **You may come in the building to sign your child out.**

\*Dismissal is at 3:30. We ask that you avoid picking them up early, unless you have a set appointment. All students should be in the bus/pick-up line by 3:40, making for a quick dismissal. The students will go to the east side of the building, near the main entrance, for dismissal. A staff member will not release them without visual confirmation as to who is picking them up. This is for the safety of our students.
