**Remote Learning for Snow Days:** Below are the expectations and procedures at West Holmes Local Schools for remote learning when school is closed due to inclement weather. The goal is to ensure continuity of learning while providing clear, consistent expectations for students, families, and staff.

- **Secondary Student Expectations (Grades 6–12)**

- **Technology Access:** Students are expected to take their Chromebook home each day.
- **Assignments:** Students are responsible for completing all assigned work by the posted due dates. Assignments will be posted in Google Classroom and may include instructional videos, interactive activities (e.g., discussion posts), virtual class meetings, or independent assignments.
- **Submission Timeline:** Students will have up to two (2) school days after returning from the final snow day to complete and submit assigned work.

- **Communication**

- **Primary Communication/Assignment Platform:** Google Classroom will serve as the primary platform for assignments and communication.
- **Additional Communication:** Teachers will be available during the designated times of 10am-12pm and 1pm-3pm, to respond to questions. Teachers and students may use Email, Google Classroom, and/or Google Meet to communicate with students and families, as needed.

- **Assessment and Grading**

- **Summative Assessments:** Tests and other summative assessments may be adjusted, modified, or postponed depending on the length of the school closure.


