  - **Notes for each grade level:**
    - Freshmen and sophomores will not attend. This day will be a remote learning day for all freshmen and sophomore students. All assignments are to be posted on Google Classroom.
    - All 11th-grade students (including career center and eLearning students) will attend school at the high school. The testing will run from 7:25 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Testing rooms for students will be posted outside the high school office and Mrs. Gardner will meet with all Juniors to talk about the testing today (February 19) and Friday (February 20). Students who arrive after 7:35 am will not be permitted in the testing room. Once the test is complete, students are free to leave for the day. The cafeteria will be open if students would like to eat lunch before they leave. The buses will run at normal times. If students do not have a ride home, they will report to the commons for the remainder of the day.
    - Seniors will not attend. This day will be an opportunity for seniors to set up another college visit or shadow a particular job of interest. Students are responsible for setting up their own job shadowing if they choose this route.


