Yesterday's Happenings:

- Varsity Softball lost to Wooster 8-7.
- The Varsity Track Teams traveled to Wooster for an Ohio Cardinal Conference dual meet and both squads had several strong midweek performances as they gear up for the Triway Invitational on Friday. The Boys team fell to the Generals 100-32, while the Knights Girls lost to their hosts 105-26. The Boys team was led by another Personal Best performance in the Discus by Maddax Graham who tossed the platter 165' 2" moving up the all time best list at West Holmes. He also added a second place in the Shot Put with a 49' 6.25". Chet Copper had lifetime bests in both events with a 113' 2" in the Discus and 39' 10.5" in the Shot. Seth Lowe threw 116'7" in the Discus in his personal best. Also scoring for the Knights was Rhett Chaney in the Long Jump at 20' 3" and Noah Grassbaugh in the High Jump at 5' 2". Mac Craft was 2nd in the 100 meters and 200 meters, while Jimmy Wengerd earned the victory in the 400 meters. Owen Mallasch was third in the 800 meters, while Marshall Yoder was 2nd in the 300 meter hurdles. Scoring for the Knight Girls was Mallory Marmet who won the Shot Put at 33' 6.75" and was 3rd in the Discus, Katherine Kaster in the 400 meters, Iriel Mena in the 800 meters in a Personal Best of 2:25.78, Breslyn Brown, 2nd in the 800 and 3rd in the 100 meters, Alizah Sigler 3rd in the 400 meters and the 4X400 squad of Breslyn, Sophie Arnold, Chelsea Cooper and Katherine winning the relay in a season best of 4:35.56.


