Yesterday's Happenings:

- Varsity Boys Soccer caged the Cambridge Bobcats with a 6-3 win. This game was action packed from the opening whistle to the full time whistle. Junior defender Caleb White got the opening goal for the Knights in the 15th minute. Oliver Hiller took his patented flip throw from the touchline, Ryder Fox got a head on the throw and Caleb hammered it home! Senior, Garrett Obrst scored off a Ryder Fox assist in the 34'. The Knights would take the 2-0 lead to the half. Oliver Hiller got the Knights on the board again early in the 2nd half, scoring off an Obrst assist in the 41'. Ryder Fox got in the scoring column with a goal in the 49' from an Obrst assist. Junior, Jimmy Wengerd also found the back of the net off an Obrst assist in the 54'. Cambridge was not to be denied, their Junior stand-out, David Garcia found the back of the net in the 57'. This made the score 5-1. Garcia again found the back of the net, scoring directly off a corner kick attempt, he "Bent it like Beckham" as the kids used to say (73'). Sophomore, Ian McFarland responded quickly for the Knights, also scoring in the 73', a mere 30 seconds after Cambridge's 2nd goal. The Knights defense committed a foul in the box, resulting in a PK for the Bobcats in the 79th minute, which Garcia converted. The Knights played a great team game, shots, goals, assists coming from all over the pitch. Defense played well, Jordan Gerber was strong in the goal with 13 saves on the night,

some of them were massive early on in the game! Great team effort by the lads! We even our record at 2-2-0.

- JV Boys Soccer beat Cambridge 4-0. The young Knights put on a clinic, beating the Cambridge Bobcats by a tally of 4-0. Keith Kaster scored the first 3 goals for the Knights (12', 14', 28'). Jackson Shriver scored the 4th goal in the 33', he was assisted by Bryson Glassford. Jackson also assisted on a Kaster goal. Gavin Hoover earned his 3rd clean sheet in as many games. The Knights defense was stout, Hoover did not even have a save in the half of JV action. The JV Knights are now 2-0-1 on the season with 3 consecutive shut outs!
