- JV Boys Soccer beat Triway 3-0. Conner Allison got the JV Knights on the board in the 35th minute off a Greysen Uhl assist to take a 1-nil lead into the half. Nolan Brown scored the Knights second goal late in the second half to extend the lead, and Keith Kaster put the nail in the coffin off a Jakob Dreher assist with 33 seconds left to secure the 3-nil victory for the Knights! Gavin Hoover was a brick wall in the net for the Knights, he had his third shutout of the season and finished with 11 saves in goal.
- Varsity Boys Soccer tied Triway 5-5. Oliver Hiller had a hat trick in the first 10 minutes of this game. 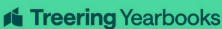
